

Case Manager II – Early Intervention

This is a full-time position within the case management department of the Mercer County Behavioral Health Commission, Inc.

This position is responsible for providing service coordination and advocacy services to a targeted population of infants, toddlers, and children with identified developmental delays. Service Coordinators will serve as the single point of contact in helping families access appropriate supports and services for their child.

A Service Coordinator assists families in linking, coordinating, and monitoring needed resources, supports, and services to ensure that the provision of early intervention services meets early intervention regulations.

Qualified candidate must have at minimum a bachelor's degree in a behavioral health or other human service related field. PA Criminal Record, PA Child Abuse and Federal FBI Clearances will be required. Competitive salary with excellent fringe benefits provided, commensurate with experience and education of the candidate.
