

- Provide a fun, safe and healthy summer camp experience
- Assist in positive decision-making
- Support personal growth
- Strengthen peer relationships



- Camp K.I.D.S.—a three week summer day camp experience.
- K.I.D.S. Club—three peer group meetings held throughout the school year.
- K.I.D.S. field trips—to the Mahoning Valley Scrappers Game, Farma Campgrounds and the Mercer County Courthouse.

A powerful ingredient to the success of Mercer County K.I.D.S. is the partnership with County School Districts. This collaboration provides an opportunity for Camp K.I.D.S. to use many of the school resources such as; facilities, equipment and buses.
